Dear Patti,

In your last note, you asked me to write to you about returning to Sudan. The answer is a big YES! I want to go and meet the people who are suffering due to the fighting, which has started again (as you have seen from the worry letter of Bishop Macram) We need to protect this generation, a war time is in the making. I need lots of MMs, holy oil, leaflets and Rosaries to reach out to them. I wish to do two things at a go:

1. We must reach Angela with materials. As I told you in my earlier communication, we use a crude way to send the boxes to Darfur! I wish to go with this dispatch also! Then, head to Rumbeck from where we use our crude but efficient ways of sending these boxes to the Islamists tightly controlled zone1.
2. I am going to spend three months working as usual. However, this time it will be intensive because we will be preparing people for either the worst of the looming war or help them divert it. Let every ULRA come to us and work toward our return to Sudan. Prayers will divert this war from the already war-torn poor souls who are at the mercy of the Islamists!

You remember, last time, for the first successful dispatch of Sacramentals to Darfur, we spent \$700 and, then, \$4,500 for the three months. I don't know whether the same amount will be sufficient for this visit. So, you can send \$3,000 and, later, you can send the remainder to me via George, our faithful friend. Let me prepare to pack my bags for travel in December. I need to inform David to arrange with the military plane because, as a soldier, he is so busy due to the present situation in Sudan

I want to share with you, briefly, about Bishop Macram Gassis! He is the former bishop of the northern Sudan diocese of El-Obeid, and the only Arab bishop in the entire Sudan! The rest are from the predominant South Sudan! He retired after death threats on his life were communicated by the Islamists of Khartoum; they see him as a challenge for the unity of Sudanese Islamist Arabs against Christian southerners! On many occasions, he has challenged the authoritative government in Khartoum! Eminent attacks intensified when he openly criticized government sponsored genocide in Darfur. He was in exile in Kenya until the signing of the Peace Accord in 2005. When Bashir, the President was sentenced by the International Court, he allowed the prelate to come back as a goodwill gesture.
